Scope: Changes made to the 209 Program

The changes are:

- Once a value has been saved in the 'Approved By' block, the 209 cannot be edited unless the hour block is changed. In other words, an updated 209 must be submitted if a change needs to be made. This prevents original 209 reports from being overwritten with new information after they have been submitted in the system.

- The ability to add individual large fires within a complex. Units and teams will now be able to bring up an additional window to enter in key information on significant fires within a complex on the 209 report. The complex radio button is on the first 209 screen.

- The Estimated Costs to Date block (19) on the 209 is now a required field. A value of zero may be entered if an incident doesn't have a cost figure. This change was to allow managers to track incidents costs on a daily basis, especially high dollar incidents. On complexes the Estimated Costs to Date will be automatically filled in from the Individual Fire Information screen.
